



In 2022, Hyundai accelerated its commitment to domestic EV production by investing more than \$10.6 billion to establish state-of-the-art EV manufacturing facilities in Georgia and Alabama, bringing our total investment in U.S electrification to over \$21 billion.

In Georgia, Hyundai Motor Group announced an initial \$5.54 billion investment\* to establish its first dedicated EV plant and battery manufacturing facility in the U.S. Combined with our partnership with SK On to invest \$4-5 billion in a battery manufacturing plant in Bartow County, Hyundai's investments in Georgia represent one of the largest economic development projects in the state's history.
